



## Sports Plus League & Tournament Rules

### AAU AND OHIO HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION RULES APPLY

- ◇ Games are 12 minute stop and go halves for 2nd thru 8th grade and 14 minute stop and go halves for High School.
- ◇ TIME OUTS PER GAME are 2 Fulls and 2 Halves TOTAL.
- ◇ Ref Fee—\$25.00 for all grade brackets. The game will not start until the ref is paid.
- ◇ THERE IS A "NO TOLERANCE" behavior policy for Players, Parents and Coaches.
- ◇ 1 Warning to Coach and Player - the second will result in a technical foul. ONLY 2 TECHNICALS ALLOWED DURING LEAGUE PLAY. Any Team or Player that starts a fight will be dismissed from the league.
- ◇ Parents are asked to remain calm - if warned and then asked to leave the facility, the team of that parent will receive a technical foul.
- ◇ Balls: 2nd thru 7th grade boys - 28.5" / High School boys - 29.5" / Girls - 28.5" 2nd and 3rd grade will use 28.5" basketball
- ◇ SCORE TABLE: Home Team will keep book / Visiting Team will keep clock.
- ◇ If a **team is up by 15 points or more**, in the 2nd and 8th grade, the **leading team cannot press** until the offensive team reaches the half court line. In addition, in the 2nd to 8th grade, **a running clock will be used in the second half when a team is behind by 30 or more points**. Regular rules will return if at any time the spread falls below 30 points. The losing coach may opt to ignore this rule at any time.

### Player Foul Rule

- ◇ Player Foul Rule for District Qualifying Tournaments, Super Regional Tournaments and National Championships
- ◇ A player will be disqualified on his or hers 5th personal foul in the 2nd grade, 3rd grade, 4th grade, 5th grade, 6th grade and 8th grade. 2 nd – 3 rd grade the foul line for these teams will be moved to 12'.
- ◇ A player will be disqualified on his or hers 5th personal foul in the 9th grade, 10th grade, 11th grade, 12th grade.
